Orphan and deeply dement, he was with us since 12 years. He was around 20 years old.





I have first refused because "I do not trust foreigner's reporters to write about the Indians 'poor without blaming them!" But eventually I relented and gave him some of my own reports and papers. From 1985 to 2017, his Foundation helped scores of NGO, to carry on, to be born or to survive. After his terrible cerebral accident, his marvelous spouse continues to help despite the funds drastically diminishing. Ten days before his death, he could not speak any more, but seemed to express his understanding that ICOD and Gopa was listening. At 91, his age and his ailment have compounded to silence his beautiful and enthusiastic voice. No one shall ever forget him, for up to-day in India, nobody has forgotten him! This month's chronicle has shown with emotion, extensive details about his whole story with us from the very beginning. And our God of love is now rewarding him in quite better ways than medals and decorations, for his generosity and compassion towards his Indian brothers and sisters.
